5. Submission Criteria and Requirements

Please read carefully. Failure to provide sufficient or accurate information and supporting documents may result in non-consideration of your application.

The Michigan Aviation Education Foundation (MAEF) Scholarship Program was established for the purpose of providing financial assistance for the advancement of education and training in aviation or aeronautics within the State of Michigan. Grants and scholarships are awarded to individual residents of the state of Michigan whose educational goals meet the MAEF mission and program guidelines which includes:

- Initial or advanced Private or Commercial Pilot training
- Technical training in an Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace related field
- College education in an Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace related field
- Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace Historical Education Programs
- Educational programs that directly promote and advance Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace Education in Michigan
- Participation as a student in research projects directly associated with the advancement of Aviation or Aerospace.

Applicant Criteria/Requirements include:

- Applicants must be residents of the State of Michigan. Proof of residency such as a current driver's license or other government issued photo ID or legal documents must be provided with the application in order to be considered.
- Applicants must submit a minimum of one-page written essay with their application addressing Part 3 Applicant Questionnaire, the selection factors, a description of their training or educational goals, and specifically identifying how the scholarship money will be used to accomplish or advance those goals.
- Applicants must submit with their application two (2) letters of recommendation from persons (not family members) or organizations who can vouch for their competence and serious intent to complete the education, training or project for which funding is being sought.
- Applicants must be able to use the scholarship funds within one year (12 calendar months) from the time the MAEF scholarship is awarded.
- Applicants who are current high school or college students must complete Part 4 of the application pertaining to their Grade Point Average and/or provide other documented proof thereof.
- Applicants must identify the training or academic institution to which the scholarship will be applied. Disbursement of the scholarship funds will be made payable to the institution or school of the applicant's choosing and an agreement may be required to be signed by the recipient and the school prior to issuance of funds.

6. Documentation and Selection Factors

As described herein, all applicants must provide a completed application form along with a short essay and supporting documents addressing the following:

1. Description of your educational training/educational need or goal;
2. What has been done already to advance your training/educational goals;
3. How the MAEF scholarship would help advance or achieve your training/educational goals;
4. Previous educational scholarships, grants and awards you have received and how those were applied to support or achieve your training or educational goal;
5. Your significant or unique aviation-related achievements;
6. Your ability and feasibility to accomplish your training/educational goals;
7. Financial need and costs involved in achieving your training/educational goals, as known, for which scholarship funds are being sought; and
8. Your involvement in aviation, aeronautics, or aerospace related organizations or activities.
9. Proof of Michigan residency (photo copy).
10. Recommendations attesting to your character, motivation, and/or ability to achieve your aviation/aerospace training and education plan and goals.
